

CITY OF CEDARVILLE
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
August 17, 2021

The regular monthly City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Isenhower after he declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Council members present were Alderman Odom, Alderman McClendon, Alderman Breshears and Alderman Johnson.

A motion to approve the July regular monthly meeting minutes was made by Alderman Breshears and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0

The financial report was presented by Treasurer Sandy Cook. End of July balances for each account were read and the August Financial Report was reviewed. A motion to approve the August Financial Report was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Grounds Supervisor Kenneth Brenton reported the department continues road repairs and has experienced mechanical issues with the roller, backhoe and grader. The roller and backhoe have been repaired. The grader is scheduled for repair for a sensor recall issue.

There was no report for the police department. Police Chief Ken Howard was ill.

Lt. Archie Hyatt reported 12 calls for the fire department, 1 fire, 1 traffic accident, and 10 medical.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Fall clean-up is scheduled October 9, 2021 from 7 a.m. to noon or until the dumpsters are full. There will be two dumpsters provided by the county will be located just east of the Fire Department behind the red gate. All standard restrictions apply.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Alderman McClendon made a motion to allow Henry Buccille of Natural Dam (a non citizen of the City of Cedarville) to speak to the council. The motion was seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 3-1

Mr. Buccille addressed a first responder call concerning a young girl suffering a severe asthma attack. He was given the allotted 3 minutes to speak.

A motion to extend Mr. Buccille's time to ten additional minutes was made by Alderman McClendon and seconded by Alderman Odom. Passed 3-1

A discussion concerning the issue and what could be learned from the situation followed. The main concern and outcome was that the young girl was administered correct assistance and transported to the hospital.

NEW BUSINESS

Treasurer Sandy Cook opened the sealed bids for the 1988 Spartan fire truck. There were two bids:

A motion to accept the bid from Trinity Group International was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0


No bids were received for the 2004 Ford Expedition. A motion to auction the vehicle after the meeting was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0

Resolution # 2021-08-17-01, authorizing the treasurer to open a separate financial account for the American Rescue Funds (ARPA) with the same required signatures of all other City of Cedarville accounts was presented by Mayor Isenhower. A motion to approve Resolution # 2021-08-17-01 was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 4-0


A motion to add a second resolution to the agenda was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 4-0
