

CITY OF CEDARVILLE
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
December 28, 2021

The Special City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Isenhower after he declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Council members present were Alderman Odom, Alderman McClendon, Alderman Breshears and Alderman Johnson.

NEW BUSINESS

The purpose of the special council meeting was to discuss the possibility of building a new Senior Citizen Center for Cedarville. Justice of the Peace Jason Cox stated the Crawford County was awarded \$12,000,000 of ARPA allotted money. Justice Cox would like to see Cedarville receive some of that allotted money in the form of a new Senior Center. He stated that a presentation would need to be made showing the need, in keeping with Covid virus restraints, such as expansion for more footage between citizens, improve ventilation, and to avoid any future flooding issues. There is no deadline but the proposal should be turned into Judge Gilstrap to present to the committee for approval before it can go to the Quorum Court. The sooner a proposal is made the more likely it could be approved. Some proposals have already been awarded. Discussion concerning location revealed two possibilities – the location of the existing center or on property behind the city fire station. A motion to meet with an architect to determine the most economical location was made by Alderman McClendon and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 4-0

With no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn was made by Alderman McClendon and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0
