CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
February 18, 2020

The regular monthly City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Isenhower after he declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Council members present were Alderman Odom, Alderman Breshears and Alderman Johnson. Alderman McClendon was absent.

A motion to approve the January regular monthly meeting minutes was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 3-0

The financial report was presented by Treasurer Sandy Cook. End of January balances for each account were read and the February Financial Report was reviewed. A motion to approve the February Financial Report was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 3-0

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Grounds Supervisor Kenneth Brenton reported that roads are being graded when weather permits. The abundance of rain has caused delays in grading roads.

Police Chief Ken Howard reported 19 citizen calls, 4 assists to other agencies, 15 citations, 28 warning citations, 0 alarms answered, 1 accident, 3 arrests, 9 felonies and misdemeanor reports filed, 3 warrants served and 19 complaint reports.

Fire Chief Cody Cooper was absent due to shift work at his full time job. No report was given.

Early voting began February 18 located at the EOC building in Van Buren or at the Alma Community Center in Alma. Hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Election day is March 3, 2020.

The Mayor received the ISO rating report for the Fire Department. The City of Cedarville Fire Department received a strong ISO "4" rating. Since the City does not have a fulltime fire department and has limited fire hydrants due to the size of waterlines, the rating cannot advance to a "3".
