

CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

February 17, 2026

The regular monthly City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Deborah Pinkerton after she declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Council members present were Alderman Neal, Alderman Burris, Alderman Johnson and Alderman Cook.

A motion to approve the January regular monthly council meeting minutes was made by Alderman Cook and seconded by Alderman Johnson. 4-0

The financial report was presented by Treasurer Sandy Cook. January end of month balances for each account were read and the February financial report was reviewed. A motion to approve the February financial report was made by Alderman Johnson and seconded by Alderman Neal. Passed 4-0

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Grounds Supervisor Kenny Brenton reported the department focused on winter weather response, equipment management, and road improvements. Multiple snow and ice treatments were distributed. Equipment repairs were made to the salt box. Some roads were graded and gravel was placed in potholes.

Officer Jones reported 44 calls for service, 4 accidents, 7 incident/offense reports, 0 alarms answered, 2 misdemeanor arrests, 8 citations, 3 warnings, 1 motorist assist, 2 code enforcements with a 30 day notice. Chief Jones has updated the policy manual for the police department.

Bryan Baggett reported 4 medical calls, 2 fire calls (1 was to assist District 4), 2 traffic accidents and 1 motorist assist.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The new senior center has been delayed by repairs and should be able to move in soon. The paving of the parking lot may be delayed until summer.

A short meeting to discuss the bingo park fundraiser will follow the council meeting.

A motion to table Resolution # 2026-02-17-01 was made by Alderman Cook and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 4-0
