CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
July 24, 2018

The Special City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Isenhower at 6 p.m. after he declared a quorum was present. Council members present were Alderman Breshears, Alderman Johnson, Alderman McClendon and Alderman Odom.

There was no unfinished business.


NEW BUSINESS

Council members discussed the list of equipment needs presented by Fire Chief Rosson. Alderman Johnson, a volunteer fireman for District 4 Fire Department, had been asked to review the list. The Fire Department has \$14,000 left in the budget for equipment. A motion to fund an additional \$7500.00 from the general account to the Fire Department to buy needed equipment was made by Alderman McClendon and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 4-0


Chief Rosson was instructed to try to recruit more volunteers. There are currently 9 volunteers on the roster.

The Council discussed returning Millpond Road and Hightower Road to the county by de-annexation. Mayor Isenhower discussed the issue with County Judge Gilstrap and he is not in favor of taking back the roads at this time but agreed to look at any plan the city develops. According to City Attorney Sean Brister, the way to de-annex city land to the county in this situation is by a vote of the citizens. A land survey is required to determine the boundaries of land to be de-annexed and an ordinance must be passed by the City Council before August 22nd for the issue to be placed on the November 2018 election ballot. Jim Hightower has offered to partner with the City for a temporary fix for a portion of Millpond Road. Mr. Hightower will pay for 10 tons of cold patch (approximately \$1,000.00) and the City will purchase an additional 10 tons of cold patch to repair the section of road discussed. Alderman McClendon expressed a need to survey the traffic on Millpond road to determine use by county residents versus city residents.

With no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn was made by Alderman Odom and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 4-0
