
AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2016-2-16-2, REPEALING ANY OTHER CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Cedarville City Council has determined that due to the small size of its workforce, random drug screening is not effective nor helpful nor necessary to protect the City or its residents and causes a disproportionate financial burden relative to its effectiveness and benefits for the City;
