CITY OF CEDARVILLE CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES September 21, 2021

The regular monthly City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Mark Isenhower after he declared that a quorum was present. A moment of silence was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Council members present were Alderman McClendon, Alderman Breshears and Alderman Johnson. Alderman Odom was absent due to family illness.

A motion to approve the August regular monthly meeting minutes was made by Alderman Breshears and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 3-0

The financial report was presented by Treasurer Sandy Cook. End of August balances for each account were read and the September Financial Report was reviewed. A motion to approve the September Financial Report was made by Alderman Breshears and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 3-0

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

Grounds Supervisor Kenneth Brenton reported the department continues road repairs and has experienced mechanical issues with the backhoe that have been repaired. The department moved the large dirt pile by the Fire Department.

There was no report for the police department. Police Chief Ken Howard was absent due to work related issues.

Lt. Archie Hyatt reported 16 calls for the fire department, 1 fire, 1 vehicle fire, and 14 medical.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Fall clean-up is scheduled October 9, 2021 from 7 a.m. to noon or until the dumpsters are full. There will be two dumpsters, one provided by the county and one by the city, located just east of the Fire Department behind the red gate. All Standard Landfill restrictions apply.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The 1988 Spartan Fire truck was not taken by Trinity Group International due to possible mechanical issues preventing the truck to be driven to Texas. Alderman Odom suggested the truck be listed for sale "as is" on the Purple Wave web page. After council discussion, a motion was made by Alderman Breshears to drain the oil and wait two weeks to determine if there is a definite mechanical issue. If not, replace the oil and call Trinity Group International to determine if they still want the truck. If the company does not still want it, place the truck on Purple Wave and sell it. The motion was seconded by Alderman McClendon. Passed 3-0

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Isenhower reported that 80 feet of 48 inch plastic culverts for the entrance in front of the Fire Department were bid for \$10,600 and the city would install them. After discussion, a motion to table the purchase and obtain a bid price on concrete culverts was made by Alderman Breshears and seconded by Alderman Johnson. Passed 3-0

The Fire Department needs two AEDs at a price of \$1195 each (\$2390 plus tax) and four 24 volt batteries for the tanker truck at \$395 each (\$1580 plus tax). A motion to purchase the AEDS and the batteries was made by Alderman Johnson and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 3-0

Mayor Isenhower presented Resolution # 2021-09-21-01, grant application for water improvements through the Arkansas Community and Economic Development Program (ACEDP). A motion to approve Resolution # 2021-09-21-01 was made by Alderman McClendon and seconded by Alderman Breshears. Passed 3-0

With no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn was made by Alderman Johnson and seconded by Alderman McClendon. Passed 3-0
